

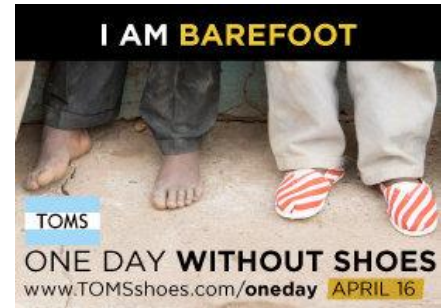

After co-founding a Campus Club during college at High Point University, I applied for an internship at TOMS Shoes in the Campus Clubs department. In late August 2010, I excitedly accepted the position and drove out to Los Angeles, California. In case you don't know, with every pair of shoes purchased, TOMS will give a pair of new shoes to a child in need. One for One.

By doing so, they are working to eliminate such issues as pododermatitis in Ethiopia (caused by silica-rich soil, almost like an elephantitis of the lower limbs), hookworm, and the simple fact that many children cannot attend school without shoes.

Here, I worked directly with students all over the world who were starting Campus Clubs just as I did to spread the TOMS story and educate as many people as they can on how much of an impact a simple pair of shoes can make in a child's life.

Starting this January 2011, I will be working as an intern at Falling Whistles, a non-profit based out of downtown LA.

Falling Whistles was started by Sean Carasso who, while on a TOMS shoe drop in South Africa, journeyed into the D.R. of Congo. Here, he learned of children too small to carry a gun, who were sent to the front lines of the deadliest war in the world armed with only a whistle. For every whistle purchased, 100% of the proceeds go towards Congolese community leaders working to rehabilitate these children, educate them about the liberties that they never knew they possessed, and help them to become "whistleblowers for peace." Ultimately, their goal is to end the war in Congo altogether.
